Hello Val Peacock,

I am reaching out to because COAs climate justice club (called: [Earth]) in cooperation with the Eco Team of the MDI High School are currently organizing a local climate strike for the 3. of march. It is going along with the “Fridays for Future” global climate strike which is happening that day. Our idea is to connect the community of MDI regarding issues of climate change and climate justice and bring awareness to different issues.

Dave Feldman gave me your contact telling me that you are a COA Alumna and chair at the Bar Harbor City Council. In regards to the strike we hope that we can register a climate march for the 3. of march, followed by a few performances and speakers in the village green.

Our idea is that people would gather for the march at COA at 10 am on the 3. of march. The march would then start at 10.15, walk down Eden Street, Cottage Street, Main Street, to arrive at the village green between 10:45 and 11:00. After the march there will be speakers and performances by COA and MDI students as well as local speakers in the village green. The strike would officially end at 12:00. So the current plan.
