The Hannaford is working hard to keep groceries and supplies on the shelves while maintaining a high level of sanitation to protect staff and customers.

Hannaford has dedicated the hour from 6-7 AM on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays as a specific shopping time for our elderly or immune compromised. They are open 7 days a week from 7am to 9pm for all other patrons.

They are stocking shelves overnight, so the best chances for getting foods and supplies that are in high demand are in the morning.

Hannaford is currently using single-use plastic and paper bags as a way to protect staff from germs found on bags that are being reused.
