Town Manager Question of the Week:

Q. If I live in Bar Harbor, do I have to go to MDI Hospital to get my vaccine?

A. No. While MDI Hospital is providing vaccinations to the public, Maine residents over the age of 70 can schedule appointments at any public facility that is administering vaccines.

The following locations are now accepting or preparing to accept appointments for residents who are 70 and over. Appointment availability is dependent on vaccine supply. These listings are subject to change and will be updated regularly and can be found on this website.

Covid Transmission Update

- MDI Hospital confirmed 72 positive tests to date
 - 64 Hancock County Residents
 - 8 Other (non-residents)
- As of today 2/25/21 Maine CDC has confirmed 888 positive cases to date in Hancock County. This is an increase of 22 cases in the last week.
 - 2/18 - 866 positive cases
 - 2/11 - 835 positive cases
 - 2/4 - 807 positive cases
 - 1/28 - 766 positive cases
 - 12/31 - 550 positive cases
 - 11/26 - 235 positive cases
- The current case rate for Hancock County is 162 per 10k people
- The current case rate for the State of Maine is 329.6 per 10k people
