## Public Vaccination

*If you are fully vaccinated (14 days after final dose), you do not need to quarantine after exposure or travel.* - Nirav Shah, during 3/18 Maine CDC briefing.

The following locations are now accepting or preparing to accept appointments for residents who are 60 and over. Appointment availability is dependent on vaccine supply. These listings are subject to change and will be updated regularly and can be found on this website.

**NEW:** Vaccination sites [will soon start offering appointments](#) to Maine PreK-12 teachers and school staff, and workers at licensed child care facilities. Federal policy directs Hannaford, Walgreens, and Walmart pharmacies to prioritize these workers. It may take time for appointments to become available. Age-eligible individuals may still also make a vaccine appointment at one of Maine's [vaccination sites](#).

- 341,842 first doses
- 203,260 second doses (15.12% of the Maine population)

## Covid Transmission Update

- MDI Hospital confirmed 86 positive tests to-date
  - 78 Hancock County Residents
  - 8 Other (non-residents)
- As of today 3/18/21 Maine CDC has confirmed 976 positive cases to-date in Hancock County.
  - 3/11 - 954 positive cases
  - 3/4 - 925 positive cases
  - 2/25 - 888 positive cases

- 1/28 - 766 positive cases
- 12/31 - 550 positive cases
- 11/26 - 235 positive cases
- The current case rate for Hancock County is 178.1 per 10k people
- The current case rate for the State of Maine is 357.4 per 10k people
