## NOTES

- All Shellfish Licenses expire on June 30.
- You are allowed to dig one (1) peck per day of a combination of soft-shell clams, quahogs, razor clams, and oysters, and a half bushel (2 pecks) of hen clams. A peck is equal to approximately 2.4 gallons (in their shells, unshucked).
- No more than 10% of your shellfish can be under legal size.
- You cannot sell shellfish with a recreational license.
